



GOLF CART POLICY

Due to congestion and insurance regulations, only golf cart type vehicles (no atvs etc) are allowed on the fairgrounds. **All golf carts must be pre-registered.** If submitting a campground form, please include the golf cart registration. A fee of \$25 will be assessed for each golf cart. You must be 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart on the grounds. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in the impounding of the cart. **Any golf cart type vehicle not pre-registered by August 1 will be assessed a fee of \$100.**

1. All carts must be registered in the fair office .
2. Each cart will be issued a permit for use in designated areas only.
3. No carts are allowed in the Midway or in the Grandstand area after 12:00 noon except for Fair Operations & Emergency calls.
4. No carts are allowed on the Livestock Mall at any time.
5. Any golf cart left unattended with a key in it can be impounded
6. Operators must be 18 years of age or older and have a valid drivers license.
7. A twenty-five dollar (\$25) registration fee must be paid in the Fair office at time of registration unless proof of insurance is provided. **Any golf cart not pre-registered by August 1 will be assessed a fee of \$100.**
8. The speed limit on the Fair grounds is ten (10) mph or less at all times. There will be a warning for first time violators. Second time violators will have their vehicle impounded for the remainder of the week.
9. **There is a golf cart curfew beginning at 10 p.m. except for Fair Operations (i.e. Fair related, Security & Emergency calls). If violated, golf cart may be impounded for the week.**
10. **Night Security has the authority from the Fair Board to impound golf carts from violators.**
11. All rented golf carts must be returned to the County Center Building and key turned into the Fair Office by 10 p.m. Saturday night (last night of the fair).
12. Carts may not carry more passengers than the cart is designed to carry.
13. The fair board reserves the right to revoke any golf cart permit for violations of these rules and regulations. No refunds will be made.
14. If a golf cart permit is revoked, the cart will be required to leave the premises.
15. Carts issued permits for the livestock area will be able to use their carts between the hours of 6 AM – 10 AM.
16. Carts issued permits for Commercial vendors and Concessionaires must remove their carts by 12 noon.
17. The registration permit shall be permanently fixed to the vehicle at all times and is not transferable to other vehicles.

The fair board's decision on all matters is final. Persons with medical conditions should consider renting Amigos as they are allowed everywhere on the grounds. (The Fair board does not rent Amigos).

We want everyone to have a safe week at the Fair and request that you comply with these simple rules.
