2011 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Each driver and mechanic has an obligation to read the rules for their best interests.

In the interest of safety, drivers and mechanics are subject to, and must obey, the following rules and regulations which are set up by the Kalamazoo County Fair where this event is being held:

1. Each driver must complete an entry blank, only one entry per person per class and two entries per truck per class.
2. All trucks must have current registration and insurance to be eligible. Driver of the truck must have a valid driver's license. Those under 18 years of age must have a release signed by his/her parent or guardian.
3. A pit pass will be issued to the driver and 1 mechanic. Each additional pit pass will be \$10. All persons must sign a release form and receive a pit pass to be allowed in the pit area or on the track.
4. NO alcoholic beverages in pit area or on the track. Any driver or pit person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be disqualified and removed from the grounds immediately.
5. Trucks must enter fairgrounds at South Olmstead gate.
6. Trucks must be inspected before registering. Inspections and registrations will begin at 4pm and close at 5:30pm.
7. Passengers are not allowed in the truck while pulling.
8. Driver must wear seat belt while pulling.
9. Contestants are allowed two attempts within the 75ft. measurement. Driver must make an honest effort to stop before the marker.
10. Any driver or crew member disobeying the rules will cause his/her truck to be disqualified. Unsportsmanlike conduct, reckless/careless driving will not be tolerated and is cause for disqualification from current and/or future events.
11. If you are disqualified there will be no refunds.
12. On the day of the event, once the first pull begins there will be no refunds.
13. If you pre-register and cannot attend, your money will NOT be refunded after August 1, 2011
14. Full pulls will result in a pull off.
15. The fair is not responsible for any vehicles, parts, or personal property before, during, or after the pulls.
16. If decided by the promoters at any given time, these rules can and will be altered or added to in order to facilitate the safety and integrity of the event. They reserve the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
17. The judge's decision are final. There will be no protest of rules.

18. *There will be 9 classes of antique/farm stock tractors:*
19. *Tractors must run on manufacturer's recommended fuel.*
20. *Tractors may not exceed more than 10 percent of factory high idle.*
21. *Tractors must retain stock engine and stock appearance.*
22. *No altered tires by cutting or grinding will be allowed. No dual tires allowed.*
23. *All weights must be secured to the tractor. No weights permitted on seat or deck, this includes cab tractors. Any ballast or external parts lost while hooked to the sled will be cause for disqualification.*
24. *All tractors must start with a tight chain. Do not jerk the sled.*
25. *Driver must remain seated during the pull with at least one hand on the steering wheel.*
26. *Tractor motor and chassis must confirm with one another, including carburetor and injection system.*
27. *The number one puller will be the test puller and may take the pull if the working conditions of the weight machine is satisfactory. Driver will have the option to take the pull or drop to the 6th pulling position. All decisions on re-pulls must be made before leaving the track.*
28. *Each contestant may spot the sled for their pull. Contestant must notify track official or sled operator before sled is backed into track position.*
29. *All tractors competing must run on a working governor.*
30. *There is a 20" maximum draw bar height. There is an 18" minimum draw bar length from center of the rear axle.*
31. *Judges have the right to re-weigh or re-tech any tractor, any time, during or after the pull.*
32. *Each class must have at least two entries.*
33. *Two drivers per tractor allowed.*
34. *Each puller has two attempts to make it past the 20ft. mark. The pull is official once the 20ft. mark is passed.*
35. *Maximum sled speed is 4mph.*
36. *Tractors must enter fairgrounds at Olmstead gate.*
37. *Open Class Rules: Tractors must run at factory horsepower. MFWD, Track, and Articulating tractors are allowed but must be rated under 350 HP. All other previous rules apply to the open class except there will be no speed limit.*

Antique/Farm Stock Tractor Premiums

Antique/Farm Stock Tractor Premiums: Dept. 3 Section B

There will be nine classes of antique/farm stock tractors. They are as follows:

- *Class 2402* *4,000lb*
- *Class 2403* *6,500lb*
- *Class 2404* *9,000lb*
- *Class 2400* *10,000 lb*
- *Class 2401* *13,000 lb*
- *Class 2405* *11,000lb*
- *Class 2406* *15,000lb*
- *Class 2407* *19,000lb*
- *Class 2408* *Open Class*

The premiums for each class are as follows:

- *1st place - \$40*
- *2nd place - \$30*
- *3rd place - \$20*
